THEODORE ROOSEVELT WILLIAMS, son of the late James Henry and Julia J. Williams, was born on April 23, 1940 in Hamilton, NC. He departed his life on June 21, 2007 after years of medical illnesses. Theodore (Ted or The) to most of us who knew him, moved to Washington at the early age of three years old. He received his education in the DC school system, graduating from Banneker McKinley Tech. From high school, he joined the army. After serving in the army, he re-enlisted in the U. S. Air Force where he then transferred to the Medical Corpsman Unit and served until 1967, after serving in Vietnam in 1966. Ted served in the military medical field for many years until he retired in 1991 after Operation Desert Storm. Ted continued his education at Federal State College, transferring to Howard University and majoring in Social Welfare Sociology, graduating in 1984. He then transferred out of Military Medical Services to the Medical Service Department in the DC Department of Corrections. Ted received numerous citations, awards and medals for his exemplary military services. Anyone who knew him knew that his favorite pass time was playing cards with his poker buddies faithfully every Saturday and going to Delaware Park to curse out the folks and gain his winnings. He leaves to cherish his life: his fiancé of fourteen years, Sherby D. Thomas and two adopted sons, Corey and Shaunta, all of the home; a daughter, Paris J. Evans and son-in-law, Michael C.
