September 12, 1933 - May 5, 2018

Theodoric Roy Evans, “Ted,” the fifth child of the late Margaret Elizabeth Evans (nee Roy) and Arthur R. Evans, Sr., was born September 12, 1933 in Baltimore, Maryland. He attended the Baltimore City Public Schools.

Theodoric was baptized at Providence Baptist Church by the late Reverend Eugene White. Ted was very active in the life of the church. He was a member of the Men's Fellowship, The Open Bible Sunday School Class and the VAR Club. He joyfully greeted all who entered the the doors of the church. He also graciously assisted with the coffee hour that followed the 7:45 a.m. worship service.

On November 12, 1953, Ted entered the U.S. Army and served in the Korean War and was discharged from the Armed Services with honor on September 14, 1955. He, for many years, was active with the VFW, the American Legion and the Cooties (a Veteran Organization).

In 1956, he began his employment as a Route Distributor with the Baltimore Afro-American Newspapers. Additionally, he was an insurance agent. Theodoric is also remembered as a ardent worker in Voter Registration Drives.

On October 26, 2001, Theodoric married Mary Joyce Evans. Together, they

enjoyed entertaining and dining at various restaurants. Ted experienced a very loving relationship with his family. He especially loved watching football on the television!

After a lengthy illness, Theodoric R. Evans entered into Eternal Rest on May 5, 2018.

Ted leaves to cherish his memory: his wife, Mary; sister Gloria Evans; three brothers, Henry Evans (Brenda), Denzlow Evans, Sr. (Linda) and Deacon Malcolm Evans (Barbara); a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives and friends.

Ted was preceded in death by five brothers, Arthur Evans, Jr., James Evans, Cassius Evans, Hugh Evans, Sr. and Deacon William Evans.
