As an employee of the Baltimore City Health Department Theresa compassionately served as a Health Aide in the Baltimore City Public Schools for the last 22 years of her life. Theresa has been an active member of Saint Ann's Church for many years. She was a choir member, a member of the Leadership Team, the BUILD Action Team and would help out whenever called upon. She sincerely loved her church and her church family. She was very active in her community and was instrumental in the planning of the annual Pindell-Hawkins Family Reunion. Theresa shared many enduring and loving relationships that included her loving goddaughters, Brandi and India and life long friends, Wilma, Janet and Debbie. All of her family, friends and neighbors were also aware of Theresa's remarkable love of animals and her willingness to love and care for them. One of her last inquiries to her brother was "Lenny, do you know anyone that has

any kittens?" She leaves to celebrate her life: two daughters, Chevonne Adams and Kia Harris; one brother, Leonard Pindell; one son-in-law, James Adams; one sister-in-law, Charlene Pindell; three grandchildren, Jahbrie, Kailah and Nijaiya; aunts, Mary Conway, Ella Yarborough and Irma Faulcon; uncles, Lewis and Edgar Pindell; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives and friends.
