Theron Napoleon Davis, Jr., son of Theron N. Davis, Sr. and the late Rose Baskerville Davis entered eternal peace October 8, 2016, at home after a long courageous battle with cancer. He was born July 16, 1966 in Richmond, Virginia. He went to live in Henrico County at the age of three and was educated in Henrico County public schools. Theron Jr. joined Second Baptist Church at an in early age. He graduated from Highland Springs High School in 1984 where he set records on the Track Team. His long jump record is still unbroken as well as his record for the fourth leg on the 100 is still unbroken. He then enlisted in the United States Marines Reserves: He was a member of the House of Ogburn, Richmond Virginia Branch.

He met the love of his life Idiyatu "Peaches" Brooks-Davis at Highland Springs High School. The best friends were blessed to be together for 32. Years. Theron was blessed with two children, Tarez A. Tompkins and Tre'von W. Davis.

Theron was employed at the Richmond Convention Center until his health failed. He was loved on his job and he loved to make sure the convention center was "spotless".

Theron considered himself a "Master Griller". He loved smoking ribs and making barbecue. His other love was telling jokes and making people laugh.

You couldn't sit next to him at a meal without getting into trouble laughing.

Theron was preceded in death by his mother, Rose B. Davis, and maternal and paternal grandparents.
