### Legacy of Love

Attorney Thomalyn Ann Epps, 42, peacefully transitioned into eternal life with the Lord on Tuesday, October 15, 2019. Attorney Thomalyn Ann Epps was born on September 17, 1977 to the union of Drs. Ruth W. and Thomas H. Epps, Jr. She was blessed to have been nurtured by an openly spirited Christian family, who shared and fostered love, Christian values, a benevolent spirit, and an appreciation for learning in Thomalyn.

At the early age of eight, Thomalyn accepted Christ and was baptized into the fellowship of Ebenezer Baptist Church, Richmond, Virginia. She was an active Church School member, beginning her participation in the kindergarten class and continuing through the youth senior level classes and participating in plays and recitations. She enjoyed scouting and was a member of the scouts as a Brownie, Junior, and Senior Cadet. Her favorite scouting activities were working on badges, outings, and trips. Thomalyn was a member of the junior ushers, the acolytes, and Ebenezer's youth band.

Thomalyn was educated in Chesterfield County Public Schools and graduated from Manchester High School with Honors. She furthered her education at the University of Maryland, College Park, Maryland by earning a Bachelor of Arts in Government and Politics, December 1999. While at the University,

Thomalyn focused her activities in the office of Minority Educational Development. Additionally, she was a Teaching Assistant, in the Criminal Justice Department – tutoring sophomore and junior students in the Criminal Justice Program. Thomalyn proctored tests and assisted professor with quizzes, class assignments, library research and other needs. Thomalyn, also worked with the Alumni Affairs Office as a part of the fundraiser team charged with keeping alumni informed of campus developments and raising money for the university.

Thomalyn furthered her quest for knowledge by entering the University of Miami School of Law, Coral Gables, Florida and earning a Juris Doctor in December 2002. A few of the activities in which Thomalyn engaged included being Advertising Editor of the *Amicus Curiae* (yearbook) 8/01-5/02; membership in the National Bar Association, the Black Sports Agents Association, and the Sports Lawyers Association. In the summer of 2001, Thomalyn was chosen to participant in the Miami School of Law London Summer Program. Additionally, Thomalyn interned in the University of Miami School of Law Center for Ethics and Public Service and taught students at Miami Senior High School ethical case studies to assist them in resolving moral and ethical dilemmas. She also, interned for Judge Carroll J. Kelly of the 11th Judicial Circuit, Domestic Violence Division, Miami, Florida with the task of assisting with research needs, observing court processes, and attending seminars on domestic violence. Thomalyn had the privilege of being a mentor with the National Lawyers Guild with the task of mentoring juveniles as part of the Juvenile Prison Project, instructing detainees on their 4th, 5th and 6th amendment rights and conducting discussions about morality. Upon graduating, Thomalyn successfully passed the July 2003 California Bar Exam.

Thomalyn began her career in Law by joining a Law Firm in San Diego, CA and was diligent in her quest to progress through the ranks. She also was a Google web-page reviewer. Thomalyn enjoyed traveling. Some of her

traveling included the United Kingdom, France, Italy, Spain, Germany, Austria, Holland, and Canada. Her relaxing time was spent writing poetry and screen plays.
