THOMAS DAVIS, son of the late George H. and Sarah Jackson Davis, was the second of ten children born in Williamsburg County, South Carolina on April 4, 1936. God whispered in his ear to come home to eternal rest on March 6, 2011 after a brief illness.

He received his education in the South Carolina Public Schools. Afterward, he worked various jobs. He later met and married the late Dorothy Gerald Davis on September 24, 1955. Out of this union he had two daughters and a stepson. Later on in life, he had two more children.

Thomas was known as "Tex" by everyone for the way he wore his wide brim hats, and that special walk no one could imitate. He loved his children, but most of all he loved his Saviour, Jesus Christ. He would have you sitting on the edge of your chair listening to him telling you about stories of the Bible and about life.

Thomas was a member of Bethany Bible Church under the leadership of Rev. Dr. Larry Davis and later Pastor, Elder Helen Jones, until he passed. He held the position as a son under the command of Louis Matthews in the American Legion Post #19 and a full member of the Baltimore Pride. He worked as a security officer until he took ill.
