I am also being kept out of your final services as they have told me absolutely nothing...All of that is ok because it will all be dealt with appropriately and legally later on but now I only have you on my mind.....When I saw you last about two years ago If I had know that it would be the last time, I would have held you so long you would have had to get another train back to New York...I was refused my rightful opportunity as your firstborn child to have closure with you and kiss you and tell you that deep inside I have always loved you...No matter what you and I may have been mad at each other about or whatever issues we may have had with each other no one had the right to take that from me...no ex-wife...no half brother...absolutely no one...You and I did not have a storybook father/ son relationship but neither did you and your dad but that is whom you have chosen to be buried with...your issues with your dad were between you and him...no one else....I am truly sorry for any and all ways that I hurt you or offended you...I know that I was not the best son in the world but I would give up about ten years of my own life just for one more day with you...I will never forget you and already I miss you...Rest in peace Dad...I love you.*
