Thomas Johnson, son of the late Mark and Carrie Johnson, was born on March 12, 1920 in Halifax County, North Carolina. He departed this life on Tuesday, December 9, 2003 at 12:40 a.m. Thomas received his education from Halifax County School in North Carolina. He left for Fort Bragg, North Carolina on May 27, 1942 to enter the United States Army. While in the Military he married the late Beatrice Clark Johnson on September 11, 1945 in Baltimore, Maryland. On September 29, 1945 an Honorable Discharge was given from the United States Army. He received the EAMET CAMPAIGN MEDAL with three Bronze Service Stars, and Marksman on M1903. He worked at Bethlehem Steel Corp. and retired after 37 years of service. Conversion came to him at an early age, and he was baptized in Christ at Tillery Chapel Church. He served faithfully there until he came to Baltimore, Maryland where he became a member of the Central Baptist Church in 1966. On August 3, 1979, he lost his wife of 34 years, Beatrice. Thomas was a loving husband and devoted father to his four children, Marian Johnson, Thomas Johnson, LaVerne Atkinson and Jacqueline Harris.
