THOMAS JUNEST MCCAULEY departed this life on Saturday August 12, 2017 in the early afternoon. Thomas was the youngest son of Ollie & Herbert Macaulay, born March 1, 1932 in Morven, N.C.

He received his early education in the North Carolina public school system. He was employed at the Bethlehem Steel Corp in Dundalk, Md. For over 42 years prior to retirement.

Thomas was a devoted husband, father, and loyal servant of the Lord. He received the Lord as his personal savior at an early age and was in active servant hood for 60 years. Thomas became an ordained minister under the leadership of R. G. Hardy of Faith Tabernacle Pentecostal Church of southeast Baltimore.

Thomas and his first wife later joined New Solid Rock Church under the leadership of Pastors Bennett and Jean Donnell, where he served for many years on the youth ministry for the Charles H. Hickey School for boys, served on the usher board, Aides – HIV ministry, and Nursing Home ministry until his health issues no longer allowed him to serve.

Thomas married his first wife Mary Cardell in April, 1957 and was married to her for 39 years until she preceded his death. From this union were born six

children, Arnetta, who preceded him in death Denise, Thaddeus, Terry, Linda, and Shantel who are left to cherish his memory. In August 1977, Thomas married Cecelia Smith of Baltimore and was in this union for 20 years, before he expired.

Thomas was preceded in death by: his four brothers, Frank, Clyde, Lonnie, and TJ; two sisters, Aretha and Mae Belle; sister-in-law, Willie Lee; and grandson, Teddy, Jr.
