Thomasine received additional training in the Health field and in Computer Technology. Thomasine had numerous accomplishments and achievements. Thomasine was employed as a nurses' aide and more recently as a secretary for the Human Resource Department at Baltimore City Community College. As a child, Thomasine faithfully accompanied to church. It was there that she recognized and utilized her gift for singing. Her first solo was "The Lord's Prayer." As she struggled through the vicissitudes of life she constantly turned to the Lord, affiliating with different churches for help and strength her struggles. She found solace with the Lord at the Memorial Institution of God where she fellowshiped for the last five years and where she accepted the Lord as her Savior, was baptized, and filled with Holy Ghost.
