the Restaurant, he was the resident “Go-to” resourceful person, playing Frosty the Snowman. Tim also was a staple employee of the first Sports Bar downtown: Downtown Sports Exchange. His stories covered all the major conventions that came to town, and colorful commentary especially the “Delta Sigma Theta” ladies who kept him jumping. While at the Golden Arm, Tim shined as an exemplary employee until their closing. Where he was a kind spirit to the children, and patrons near his space. Tim gained amazing cooking skills from the Hispanic brand of cooking; which led to huge and intricately prepared sides for every Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday. He was so proud to contribute to the family as a whole on multiple levels.

He was also a 15-year employee of the Downtown Locker Room, where he was honored with a clock trophy marking his many years of devoted service to all the 6 locations which he spent countless hours traveling to on an on-call basis to be present, and protect the staff.
