



## Timothy E. Footman

September 27, 1960 - January 15, 2021

Timothy Edward Footman was born September 27, 1960 in Baltimore, Maryland. He transitioned unexpectedly on Friday, January 15, 2021. Timothy was the youngest child of the late George and Pearl Footman. He was the couples only son and they affectionately called him “Timmy”.

Timmy was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. He attended Walbrook Senior High School. While in school, he excelled at visual arts, played varsity football and began to cultivate his love for music. Under the guidance of his high school music teacher “Mr. Mac”, Timmy learned how to read sheet music and to play the piano. Throughout his teen years, he developed a deep passion for sports, martial arts, and musical performance. He wrote songs, studied kung fu, and taught himself how to play the drums. He would often talk to his family and friends about his career aspirations as a P-Funk musician.

After graduating high school in 1979, Timmy attended AIRCO Tech, a trade school for welding, in Dundalk. He received his welder’s certification and was offered a position as a welder at Bethlehem Steel. Timmy continued to hone his craft as a musical artist. Soon after becoming a welder, Timmy and a former welding school classmate, Cornelius Roundtree, decided to form a band. They along with another member, Rick Warren, would go on to form the trio “PRESTIEGE”. Under the stage name “Footy”, he performed as the

group's drummer, producer, and vocalist. The band's sound was heavily influenced by P-Funk, R&B Soul, and gospel. The trio recorded music in addition to touring the DMV area playing professionally at bars, lounges, and clubs for many years.

In the late 80's, Timmy was diagnosed with a chronic medical condition that rendered him permanently disabled. Despite his many obstacles, he was still able to thrive, because of his faith in God and the love and support of his family. Although his life had changed, his passion for music never waivered. He spent a lot of time curating music from his favorite musicians like the Artist Formerly Known as Prince, George Clinton, and Hezekiah Walker. He would often entertain his family and friends with impromptu home jam sessions. He was also a hometown sports enthusiast who never missed a Baltimore Ravens or Orioles game.

Timmy was a loving son, a loyal brother, and a caring uncle. He was adored by his family and friends. He remained humbly true to himself and his passion for music and the people he loved. He will be sorely missed.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Pearl Footman, his father, George Footman and his sister, Carolyn Footman.

He leaves to mourn: sisters, Cynthia Young and Cheryl Rich (Gregory Rich); nephews, Duane Young and Derek Young; nieces, Ashley Rich, Erika Young, Brennae Nixon, and Brittany Rich; several great-nephews and niece and a host of relatives and friends.
