Toney Warren Brown, age 55, passed away early Friday morning, January 26, 2018 at Chippenham Hospital in Richmond. He was born on July 22, 1962, in Charles City, Virginia, to the late Robert "Skinny" and Rosa Estelle Jones Brown. He is preceded in death by his brother Ricky Brown.

He was baptized at an early age and had a connection to God that was undeniable by his walk in life. 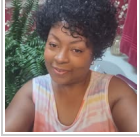
