Tori enjoyed working as a Salesperson and held several sales positions as a young lady. Tori always had a passion for helping others, and this quality led her to pursue a career as a 911 Dispatcher for the Baltimore City Fire Department. Tori worked at the Fire Department for several years, until an injury forced her to retire from this position.

Until about 2 years ago, Tori was a budding entrepreneur. She enjoyed managing a successful Online Business with her cousins, Anthony Johnson and Jermel Adams. Tori had a nation-wide client base, and arranged to deliver Hair Supplies, and Fashion Accessories through her mail order business. She would make her own wigs by hand to order, and she would embellish the shoes with stones and pearls and did the same with cellphone covers. Tori had a fondness for fashion and enjoyed shopping for fine clothes.

Tori and her brother Derek were very close. They always found time to talk, and they would even watch cartoons together. Tori's love for music, and everything Michael Jackson had a huge impact on her brother. Tori had a large collection of Michael Jackson albums, books, and memorabilia.

Tori was a strong, confident, independent, and caring person, who loved taking care of others. She loved to travel (especially to California), and often went on cruises with her cousins. Taking care of others and making sure they stayed on top of things made her happy. Tori was the type of person that would give you the shirt off her back and never asked for anything in return. Always smiling, extremely talkative, hard worker, and always giving of herself is just a few things that describes who she was.

Tori would not think twice to take you to the store, or to your doctor's appointment, and made sure you had food in your refrigerator; she cared about your well-being. She would help if you needed a place to stay or a car to drive (she had two), and never once looked for anything in return. Tori had a wonderful personality, and an affectionate smile.

Tori loved to cook and enjoyed watching the Cooking Shows on Cable TV. The family loved eating Tori's special dishes, which were Crab Cakes, Macaroni & Cheese, and Lasagna. Two of the desserts that Tori often prepared for family and friends were her Pineapple Upside Down Cake, and a 3-Layer Coconut Cake. She even prepared these specialties for her mother Lee to take to work, where she would share these dishes with her co-workers. Often times, Lee's co-workers would ask if Tori could make one of these dishes especially for them.

Tori also liked to dine out at various restaurants and eating good food. Tori enjoyed going to the Hazelwood Inn with her cousins; they would often get together on Fridays for Happy Hour and for each other's birthday, spending hours in the restaurant talking, laughing, and enjoying each other's company while they ate.

Over the last two years Tori endured a lingering illness, but she never complained. One of her favorite sayings was "God is good all the time, and all the time God is good."

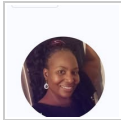

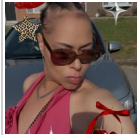
