TROY CHESLEY, SR. was born the son of John and Joyce Chesley on November 29, 1972. On the morning of January 9, 2007 the Lord called Troy home. Troy was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. He attended Baltimore City College High School where he majored in Business. At the age of fourteen he entered the workforce working at Cala Brothers and Triple C Wholesalers. In 1993 Troy began his Law Enforcement career joining the Baltimore City Police Department as a Police Cadet. Upon graduating from the academy he was assigned to the Western District. During his tenure he was assigned to Criminal Investigation Division District Detective Unit (Northwest), Tactical Mobile Enforcement Team, Firearms Strike Team, Organized Crime Division (Undercover Narcotics), Special Operations Section, and Public Housing (Special Teams on Patrol). Troy received a Life Saving Award for leading several people from a burning dwelling. He also received Unit Citations for Excellence in outstanding performance as a member of the law enforcement community. Troy leaves to cherish his memory: his mother, Joyce Chesley; father, John Chesley; stepmother, Wanda Chesley; brother, Leroy Pinder, Jr.; sister-in-law, Marcia Pinder; two grandmothers, Evangeline Kent and Lorraine Chesley; two grandfathers, Joshua Harrison and James Kent (he was preceded in death by grandfather John Fields); three sons, Troy, Trayvon and Ryan; two daughters, Chasity and Rayvn Chesley; aunt, Bernice Marshall of Kingsville, Virginia; a host of aunts, uncles, nieces and devoted friends.

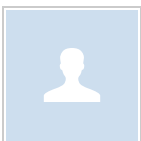

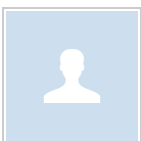
