Tshimanga Honore Mubiayi was born on October 15, 1953 in Kananga, The Democratic Republic of Congo. He was the second of nine children to the late Tshimanga Mubiayi Sr. and Bitshilualua Mubiayi. His brothers and sisters include Miandi, Pierre, Marie, Mbombo, Kashama, Jean, Remy and Henry.

He attended Catholic school and later earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from the National University of Zaire in 1976 back in his home country. After graduating he taught courses in Educational Psychology at Teacher Training College in his home town of Kananga (1976-1979), and subsequently at Teacher Training College at Kisangani (1979-1983) in eastern Congo. In 1991 he arrived in the United States of America to follow his dreams and make a better life for his children. He continued with his education later earning a master's degree in Clinical Psychology from North Central University in 1997, and a Collegiate Professional License in French from the Commonwealth of Virginia in 2007. He worked in customer service and healthcare until 2007 and decided to follow his passion and go back to teaching. In Fall of 2007, he became a French Teacher at Churchland Middle School and in 2011, he began teaching at W. Wilson High School in Portsmouth, VA.

Tshimanga Honore Mubiayi is preceded in death by his father, Tshimanga Mubiayi Sr.; mother, Bitshilualua Mubiayi; his sister, Mianda; his brother, Jean

and his first-born son, Ntumba Patrice Mubiayi. He is survived by his last spouse, Konjit, who took care of him until untimely death on February 6, 2019. He was a proud father to seven daughters, Nicole, Lydia, Deborah, Nathalie, Vanessa, Ruth, Priscilla; two sons, Isaac and Honore Junior; He was a grandfather to Jacques, Glovie, Nathan and Abraham.
