Tyrone Leon Blackwell, Sr. entered this world on June 10, 1954, and went home to be with his Heavenly Father on July 17, 2025.

He was born in Baltimore, Maryland and was the youngest of four children born to Eddie Lee and Arsenia Blackwell. He was raised with his two brothers, Edward and Jerome and his sister, Eugenia in the Cherry Hill neighborhood of Baltimore. He was baptized at an early age at First Baptist Church of Cherry Hill.

Tyrone was educated in The Baltimore City Public Schools System. He attended Carver Vocational High School, where he starred as a member of the school's track team. He held the city's 440-yard dash record for many years after he graduated. While at Carver he met and fell in love with Cynthia Goodson. They would later marry on October 27, 1973, and remain so until his passing. From their union two children would be born: Tyrone, Jr and Tynacia. Following high school, he would join the United States Marine Corps and would serve honorably for six years. Tyrone and Cynthia raised their family in West Baltimore, as he made a living as a printer-pressman until his retirement in 2011.

Tyrone was very athletic, lifting weights almost daily in his twenties and thirties. He could frequently be seen jogging from his home to Gwynns Falls reservoir and back. He enjoyed watching sports, and when the Ravens came to

Baltimore in 1996 he immediately became a die-hard fan. His closets were full of purple and black jerseys, jackets and hoodies of his favorite team. He was also an avid collector of tools, though he rarely used them.

Tyrone was preceded in death by his parents, Eddie Lee and Arsenia Blackwell and his dear brother Jerome Blackwell. He leaves to cherish his memory his wife, Cynthia Blackwell; his son, Tyrone (Andrea) Blackwell, Jr; his daughter, Tynacia Blackwell; his two grandsons, Noah Blackwell and Ethan Blackwell; his granddaughter Madison Blackwell; his brother Edward Blackwell; his sister Eugenia Foster and a host of relatives and friends.
