He was educated in the Public School System of North Carolina and later attended the Agricultural and Technological College. After graduation he served in the United States Army from 1942 to 1945. He received the Good Conduct Medal and American Theater Campaign Medal and was a member of the Disabled Veterans #16. Mr. Murphy worked as an engineer with Westinghouse for over 30 years. At Westinghouse, he worked on the first Space Shuttle to successfully enter space. He leaves to cherish his memory: his beloved daughter, Ruth Long (Isaac); two grandsons, Christopher and Corbin Long; granddaughter, Charise Dickens (Todd); three granddaughters, Tiarra, Talyiah, and Sara Dickens; brother, Julius; sister, Rosa Lean Brewer; two sisters-in-law; a devoted friend, Mozell Ritter; and nephews, nieces, cousins, and a host of friends.
