Following their courtship Ulysses and Bernice married in 1956. Out of their union, two children were born. Ulysses worked as a longshoreman for over 30 years. He retired in 1970 due to a physical disability. He later went on to open his own business stand at the Northeast Market in Baltimore. Ulysses continued this endeavor until 1995. Ulysses has always had a relationship with the Lord. He visited a number of church homes before feeling led to join David Memorial Baptist Church in Baltimore in the 1980's. He remained a faithful member serving the church as a part of the Brotherhood until 1992. Ulysses was known for his sense of humor, quick wit, outgoing personality and generosity. He was always willing to help out others. Ulysses made friends wherever he went. He loved his family, friends and the Lord and often talked about "how blessed he was."
