Vanessa McLean was born to the Late Deacon Joseph H. Robinson and Deaconess Estelle R. Robinson on October 14, 1954, in Baltimore, Maryland. She was one of six siblings.

Vanessa received her education in the Baltimore City Public School System. She excelled very well in school where she was promoted from the 10th grade to the 12th grade, graduating from Eastern High School. After high school, Vanessa attended Towson University to pursue a career in the health field. She gained employment at Rite Aid pharmacy, and later became a GNA, CNA, Home Health Aide, and a Private Duty CNA. She was employed with Union Memorial Hospital for over 26 years.

Vanessa accepted the Lord as her Savior at a very early age and was baptized at the Fountain Baptist Church. She later began attending other churches before uniting with the fellowship of the Israel Baptist Church, under the Leadership of Rev. H. Walden Wilson, II on September 7, 1986. They would frequent several restaurants, as well as go to the movies, but Vanessa still asked Keith, "when we are going to have date night?" IHOP was their favorite restaurant for breakfast. Carla was their favorite server. Keith and Vanessa never failed to celebrate their wedding anniversary every year. Her sister, Danise and brother, Delanore, would always make their daily check-in phone calls to Vanessa, just to make sure she was doing well and/or to see if she needed anything. She never missed mailing birthday cards and giving holiday gifts to her family. Now, do not get it twisted, she spoke her mind and put her foot down when necessary.

On Thursday, June 13, 2024, while at home under the loving care of her dedicated husband Keith, Vanessa crossed over into glory to be with the Lord.
