VAULINE T. MALLOY was born on September 10, 1932 in Robeson County, NC, to the late Glen Thomas and Virginia Meekins Taylor. God called Vauline home on Friday, September 20, 2019, at Seasons Hospice in Randallstown, MD.

Vauline attended Robeson County Training School in Maxton, NC, receiving her diploma in June 1950. She trained in Winston Salem, NC, at the Kate Bitting Reynolds Memorial Hospital School of Nursing from 1950 until 1952 and became a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN). She worked as an LPN at Provident Hospital from which she retired in May 1996 with 33 years of distinguished service. She was an active member of the Licensed Practical Nurses Association for 30 years.

Vauline married George Frank Malloy on June 2, 1953. They were wed for forty-nine years before George preceded her in death. Their lives were filled with joy from their three sons, Robert, Michael Anthony and Kenneth.

Vauline was a faithful member of Central Church of Christ in Baltimore, MD, where she was baptized on March 4, 1976.
