



Vera Mae Abraham

July 13, 1934 - May 31, 2024

On Friday, May 31, 2024, our hearts were saddened by the passing of Vera Mae Abraham, who departed this life peacefully at home at the age of 89. Vera was born on July 13, 1934, in Darlington, South Carolina, to the late Gladys Brockington Pooler and Woodrow Pooler.

Vera received her education through the Darlington County School District, where she met the love of her life, William Abraham (affectionately known as LC). William and Vera were married on July 15, 1950, and from their union, they were blessed with five children: Woodrow Jr., Dianna Venable (Merrion Brooks), Vernisha Hendricks, Theresa Hines (Kenneth), and Ervin Anthony.

In 1955, Vera relocated from Charleston, SC to New York, where she resided for 46 years. During her time in New York, she dedicated 30 years of service at Deepdale General Hospital, retiring in 1995. Vera was a devout member of Majority Baptist Church until her move to Virginia in 2002. In Virginia, she continued her spiritual journey as an active member of St. Paul's Baptist Church, where she remained involved until her passing.

Vera was a woman of many passions, including traveling, crocheting, watching her favorite TV shows (Wheel of Fortune and Jeopardy), and playing cards. Her warmth, wisdom, and vibrant spirit touched the lives of many.

In addition to her parents, Vera was preceded in death by her two sons, a son-in-law Donald Hendricks, a granddaughter Ayesha Abraham, and a great-grandson Austin Abraham.

She leaves to cherish her memories her three daughters, her beloved aunt Albertha Roderick, 13 grandchildren, and a host of great-grandchildren, great-great-grandchildren, nieces, and nephews.
