Vernon Edwin Harris, son of Garland Edward Harris and Frances Anna Harris was born on March 14, 1929 in Baltimore Maryland. He peacefully departed this life on March 20, 2015 after a yearlong illness.

In the mid-1970's Vernon became deeply involved in the word of God.

Vernon's motto was that the Bible was a way of life. He learned, shared and practiced an unselfish love for the brethren. He would often say "love is more than a feeling, it's a duty and a responsibility." This religious experience continued to be the foundational source of his meek and humble spirit.

Vernon was known to his friends as "Wimpy" and "Uncle Vernon" to his nieces and nephews. The family always gathered at his home on Kathland Avenue for big cookouts and just good ole family dinners, Vernon was always dependable and available to lend a helping hand or to listen and give excellent advice.
