November 26, 1923 - April 13, 2014

Suddenly on Sunday, April 13, 2014, VERONICA PEACO departed this life at Sinai Hospital after what was thought to be a minor injury from a fall. Her loving family was at her bedside as she transitioned. Veronica was born in Baltimore, Maryland on November 26, 1923, the fourth of seven children to the late Dundas and Mary Nash Logan. One brother, Thaddeus, and four sisters, Mary, Lelia, Bernadette and Frances Xavier, preceded her in death. She received her education in the Baltimore City Public Schools and at the St. Frances Academy. She was devoted to the Academy and to the Oblate Sisters of Providence and tried to support their efforts in any way she could. Veronica was married to Charles Peaco in 1947 and widowed in 1980. There were no children of this union, but Veronica was the consummate aunt, grand-aunt and great-aunt. She took much pleasure in the accomplishments of her many nieces and nephews, always attending their graduations and weddings and marveling as babies were added to the family tree. Veronica always claimed a "favorite" nephew or "favorite" niece, but, in truth, each was made to believe he or she was the favorite for the names changed often according to who was present at the time. Indeed all of the nieces and nephews took much care of and time with her. Just recently she mentioned the nephew who always drove her home from family dinners — how much she enjoyed their long talks and his funny stories, the nephew who visited often and ate dinner with her at the Assisted Living Home, the nieces who shopped for her and hosted parties at the home. These were her pride and joy! Veronica was a

quiet and unassuming person. She felt blessed with her faith and her close-knit family. She was not afraid of death or of the future. She leaves to mourn, her devoted sister, Ivy Harris, an abundance of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends. Her spirit is amongst us!
