VICTOR ALBERT LEE, SR. transitioned into the arms of the Father on March 23, 2017. Born on March 20, 1955, he was the son of late Charles Lee and LaVerne Christian. He was preceded in death by his father, Charles Lee; and mother-in-law, Dorene Williams.

Vic, or VicLee as he was called by countless family and friends, was baptized at 5th Street Baptist Church and accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior at a young age. On December 25, 2016 Victor decided to give his hand to man and heart to God and joined Cedar Street Baptist Church of God. He looked forward to worshipping every Sunday, even when he was unable to attend church he would live stream from home or the hospital. He was educated in Richmond Public Schools attending John Marshall High School before leaving for the United States Marine Corps where he served from 1972-1976. After serving in the military Victor became employed with Georgia Pacific, Phillip Morris and Kaiser Aluminum where he worked as an Age Oven Operator for 23 years until his transition.

Victor was a very humble, loving, kindhearted, independent and hardworking man that believed what the word of God says in II Thessalonian 3:10: if a man

doesn't work he shall not eat. He left a lasting impact on everyone he encountered. Victor enjoyed playing basketball, watching football, and television, going to the movies, eating out, gardening and traveling. He was the biggest teaser when other people's team lost a football game. His teams were the San Diego Chargers (football), and Los Angeles Lakers (basketball). Friends say during Victor early days his basketball skills were pretty impressive, Victor would forsake his needs to help others. Victor loved his family and there was nothing big or small that he wouldn't do for them. Victor married Marilyn Williams on September 29, 2012. They would often say to each other you are the ying to my yang, the cream in my coffee, my soulmate, my friend, my lover and my king/queen. After receiving a Cancer diagnosis in December 2016 Marilyn and Victor vowed to allow God to help them walk through this journey and trusting him every step of the way. Even during the difficult days Victor would recite the 23rd Psalm and we would pray together because he thought there was nothing too hard for God. Marilyn would play Victor two favorite songs daily - "The Blood Will Never Lose Its Power" and "All of My Help Cometh From The Lord" until God called his son home.
