Mrs. Viola Glasper Green, daughter of the late Mr. Edward J. Glasper and Mrs. Susie Parham Glasper, was born June 20, 1910 in Baltimore, Maryland. After a lengthy illness she departed this life on September 14, 2001 at the Maryland General Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. She attended Fulton Baptist under Rev. Ward. Later, she was baptized and became a member of Fulton Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Benjamin F. Jackson. Rev. Jackson placed her in the Church Aid Club where she became an ardent member. Viola was also a multi-talented person. She did excellent needlepoint. Viola wove scatter rugs and tailored complete outfits including two-piece suits and dresses with hat and pocketbook to match until she lost the dexterity of her fingers at the age of eighty of eighty. Her cooking was well known throughout the neighborhood and church. She never turned anyone away from her home if they said they were hungry. The church was always asking her to bake a cake for their activities. Viola loved her church. She never allowed her illness or lack of money to keep her from making a contribution to the church. Until her death, Viola was still sending greeting cards to the sick and shut-ins on the weekly church list. She leaves to cherish her memory: one son, Lloyd J. Clasper of Baltimore, Maryland, three daughters, Laretta Glasper Reid of Baltimore, Maryland, Catherine Green of Murfreesboro, North Carolina and Ruth Barnhill of Greenville, North Carolina, one son-in-law; John Kendrick Reid and one daughter-in-law, Rosetta Glasper, Baltimore, Maryland, seventeen grandchildren, fifteen great-

grandchildren, four great-great-grandchildren and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, devoted extended family and friends.
