Vivian J. Dyer Mother, Grandmother, Great Grandmother, Aunt, Cousin, and Friend Sister Vivian Dyer gained her angelic wings and took flight on Monday, October 21, 2024 at 4:30 AM after a brief illness. She traveled through the echoes of time to be united with Yahweh. The word says to be absent from this body is to be present with Yahweh, who has dominion over the Heavens and Earth. She was born on March 28, 1931, to Bernard Bell Johnson and Emma Ann Locket Johnson at St. Phillips Hospital (MCV) in Richmond, Virginia. Both parents preceded her in death. She was one of seven siblings who all preceded her in death: Wilnet, Bernetta, Lorraine, Evelyn, Marvin, and Mamie. She was educated in the Richmond Public Schools attending Maggie L. Walker High School. She furthered her education at the Richmond Technical Center earning a certificate as a Nursing assistant. She was self-employed as a child care worker and home health aide. Her hobbies included writing, solving puzzles and crocheting. Sister Dyer joined Refuge Temple and served under the ministry of Bishop John W. Pernell. She later continued her spiritual journey under the tutelage of Elder then Bishop Milton J. Hunt. She served in the Senior Choir for over 46 years (1971-2017) under the direction of Mother Alice Pernell and later Gerald Ruffin holding offices as President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Other church-related capacities included Sunday School Teacher, Saturday Bible Study Group, and Vacation Bible School Teacher. Sister Dyer married James A. Dyer on July 30, 1949. Their union was blessed with 5 children. She leaves to cherish her memories her children Tyrone Dyer (Sylvia), Diana Woodbury (Leon), and Van Dyer, 13 grandchildren, 24 great-grandchildren and 10 great-great-grandchildren. What a legacy!
