Mrs. Vivian M. Gunter, affectionately known as Aunt Viv, transitioned from labor to reward on Monday, August 6, 2018. Vivian was born on August 28, 1935, in Baltimore, Maryland. She was the daughter of the late Samuel and Gertrude Matthews. Her four brothers and three sisters, to whom she was very close (Delores Matthews, Loretta Payne, Elizabeth Millner) preceded her in death.

Vivian was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System and graduated from Frederick Douglass High School. She continued her education, earning a Bachelor's of Arts Degree from Antioch College and a Masters of Science Degree in Adult and Continuing Education from Coppin State College. She went on to work for the State of Maryland as a Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Drug Counselor. Vivian's mission was to treat, inspire, and promote wellness within the community. Early in life, she met and married the late Mr. Garrett Gunter and together they raised their family.

Vivian's relationship with her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ was unbreakable. She was a strong and stern God-fearing woman, allowing nothing to move her from her stance with the Lord.
