Vivian loved projects: fixing things like sheds, cars, appliances and furniture. When something could not be fixed with glue she would then use hammer and nails. Vivian loved watching westerns and game shows on television. She had a passion for taking photos and maintained an extensive collection. She also loved animals, especially cats and kittens. She fed and cared for many of the cats in the neighborhood, earning her the title of “the cat lady” from one neighbor.

Vivian enjoyed socializing, spending time with family and talking on the telephone. She traveled north and south for family celebrations. She also enjoyed spending time with neighbors and friends at home. She talked regularly on the telephone to her old army buddies. Vivian will be missed.
