



## Wade Wesley Knight Sr

September 9, 1954 - December 24, 2013

WADE WESLEY KNIGHT, SR., beloved son of predeceased parents, Robert Lee Knight, Jr. and Gloria Louise (Bailey) Knight, was born in Baltimore, Maryland on September 9, 1954.

Wade grew up in East Baltimore and attended Baltimore City public schools. He further pursued his education and obtained various certifications and awards, from college, military (National Defense Service Medal, Parachute Badge) and civilian employment. After serving his country as a paratrooper with the 82nd Airborne unit of the U.S. Army, Wade was honorably discharged in 1972. He ultimately entered the Maryland State employment system, and retired as a Lieutenant of the Maryland State Corrections system (Baltimore City Detention Center).

Wade generally loved life and was “the life of the party!” His infectious smile and loving spirit made him a favorite amongst many. He always found a way to make others smile. A very compassionate person, he was supportive and caring. Wade grew up in the Christian faith and in his adult life accepted The Lord Jesus Christ as his personal Savior.

Equal to his fun-loving nature was a “no-nonsense” persona being neat, orderly and clean and respectful of both people ( especially children) and animals. He loved his pets and enjoyed horses, birds, fish and dogs. No greater earthly love did he have for anyone than his son, Wade Jr. (Nicknamed Shorty). Shorty was the apple of his eye and they shared a wonderful father and son relationship.

Widowed in April 2013 (Demetria Monet Knight), Wade leaves to mourn: his loving son, Wade Wesley Knight, Jr.; daughter, Brittany; three brothers, Keith, Michael and Phillip Knight; sister, Wanda Rhinehart Felder; and a host of loving family members, extended family members and friends.
