On Monday, August 20, 2012 Wallace Tickle Dodd, III, affectionately known as "Buttons" to family, was called home to be with the Lord. Wallace was born on August 17, 1954 in Baltimore, Maryland to the late Carrie E. Deans and Wallace T. Dodd, Jr.

Wallace received his education in the Baltimore City Public School System in Baltimore, Maryland. He was baptized at an early age at Pleasant Hope Baptist Church under Rev. Dr. Howard R. Queen.

In September of 1971 Wallace entered the United States Army and served in Germany. Upon his discharge he became employed at the United States Coast Guard until his retirement in 2010.

Wallace married the late Alameda Pride. After many years of marriage the union was dissolved. In June 2008 he married the love of his life Dolphine L. Webster.

Wallace loved sports and working with the youth. In 1989 he began coaching for Northwood Football League, the Johnson Square Baseball League in 1994, Northwood Baseball League in 1995, and the Baltimore Jaguar Semi-Pro Football Team in 2005.
