A faithful man of God, loved husband, father, grandfather, son, and brother, Rev. Walter Adams Jr., 88, of Baltimore, MD, departed this life peacefully on Independence Day, July 4, 2015. He was born September 10, 1927, in Pittsylvania County Virginia, the fifth child of the late Walter Adams, Sr. and Nannie (Jones) Adams. He was domiciled in Baltimore City Maryland shortly after birth where he attended school and then continued to self-educate throughout his life. After a long illness, Walter departed this life on Independence Day, July 4, 2015.

He married the late Rosalie Horn English in 1965. Of this union a daughter, Victoria Geraldine Adams was born. He also had four stepchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife Rosalie Adams; parents Walter, Sr. and Nannie Adams, siblings; Lois Rivers, Clyde Adams, Harold Adams and Vincent Adams, and step grandson Robert (Bobby) N. Laney, Jr.

In the early 1950's he accepted our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ as his personal Savior and testified publicly of his new beginnings with the Lord. He was a member of Mount Calvary Pentecostal Faith Church and later became a member of Faith Tabernacle Church.

For many years he had a street ministry preaching the unadulterated gospel, passing out tracts, and winning souls for God. He was a musician, he became an ordained minister, pastor, missionary and he also had a radio ministry preaching the gospel. His love of people and serving God led him to feed the hungry and pray for the sick and shut in. His love for his family led him to initiate the first Adams family reunion in Baltimore city and as you know, he also loved to eat!

He was employed with Glen L. Martin and later worked for the City of Baltimore for until he retired in 1978.
