Deacon Walter Leon Woodward , son of the late Walter and Mitchern Woodward, born on June 29, 1920, in Chester , South Carolina He was the youngest of four children.

He passed away on January 30, 2015 at the Upper Chesapeake Medical Center, Bel Air, MD after a prolonged illness.

He was a graduate of Finley High School, Chester , S. C. after graduation, he moved to Turners Station, Maryland. He became employed at the Bethlehem Steel Co. He worked there from 12/13/1939 to retirement 6/30/1982. he held several jobs at the steel mill. His last was a Millwright.
