Wanda Beatrice Macon entered into eternal rest at VCU Medical Center on June 8, 2023. She was born December 30, 1958 to the late James Franklin Macon and Lorraine Johnson Macon. Wanda was the youngest daughter of five children and grew up in New Kent County, Virginia. She graduated from New Kent High School in 1976. After graduation she worked part time while attending J. Sargent Reynolds Community College.

Wanda grew up attending Mt. Calvary Baptist Church where she was taught the word of God and later accepted Him as her Savior and was baptized. She was brought up going to Sunday School, Vacation Bible School and church on a regular basis. As an adult, she continued her Christian journey and became a member of Cedar Grove Baptist Church; where she worshiped regularly until her health began to fail. She relied daily on her faith in God to face life's challenges and her beliefs never wavered throughout years of illness. Wanda found comfort until the end listening to spiritual music and reading daily devotionals.

Wanda loved her family and touched each of their lives in special ways. Whether it was the annual birthday cake and card for nieces and nephews, or daily phone calls to keep all up to date on family news. She enjoyed several hobbies including, listening to gospel music, reading, crafting, writing poetry

and other methods of artistic expression. Family and friends will remember her as a caring and loving person. Throughout her illness she continued to show her love through her phone calls, cards and other acts of kindness.
