Wanell “Nell” Parker daughter of Louise Young and Otha Kellam received her angel wings on February 10, 2025.

Wanell was born in Dublin, Georgia on October 15, 1935. She received her education in the Georgia Public School System. After completing her education in Georgia she moved to Baltimore, Maryland where she continued her educational pursuit and graduated from Cortez Peters Business School.

After graduation she married George Nelson Parker in Baltimore, Md. from this union Wynne was born.

Her career began with the State of Maryland as a printing press operator. Through grace, perseverance and tenacity, she became the first black female Manager of Printing and Publication for the State of Maryland. Her achievement was not an easy road for that time nor for her. Her love of learning, line dancing, listening to music and spending time with friends enabled her to achieve her goal. She traveled extensively spreading joy and kindness to everyone she met along the way.

She was an excellent seamstress, gardener, cook and above all a phenomenal mother. Everyone knew that they would receive an excellent hot meal, a listening ear, no judgement, laughter, kindness and unwavering

friendship when they came to Nell's home. Her love of gardening, cooking, treating others with decency and respect will live on through her daughter.

Wanell leaves to cherish her memory: her daughter Wynne P Wall, her grand dog Sookie who laid by her side until her very last day and a host of family and friends. She was preceded in death by her mother, her husband, her son Jeffrey Denson, her sister Inez Greene, her son-in-law Bruce A Wall and her life long friend Kathleen "Kitty" Parker.
