Warrace N. Teel Sr. was born in Bethel, NC on February 21, 1921 to the late Estelle and Joe Teel.

At a very early age, Warrace and his mother moved to Maryland, where they resided in South Baltimore. He attended public school, but his education was stopped to help support his family by working at the Oriole Cafeteria and Epstein Department Store. At a young age, he married Marie Howell and from that union, one son was born.

In 1943, he was drafted and served in the United States Army during World War II with the 485th Port Battalion at Camp Harahan, New Orleans, LA.

After five months of training at Charleston, SC, he went to Newport News, VA to be shipped to Liverpool, England. He saw action during the liberation of France and participated in the Invasion of Normandy. He was proud that he achieved the rank of Sargent during his military service and from this, the 485th Port Battalion was formed and they went on to have meetings once a year in various cities where members lived, for the past seventy years.

After the war, he started working for C&P Telephone Co. from which he retired after thirty-five years of employment. In later years, he married Mary Doreathea Evans. They enjoyed traveling to visit relatives, hosting parties at

their house and having family and friends drop by to visit. Warrace loved listening to jazz music, dressing in the latest styles and he loved to eat.

He leaves cherished memory to his devoted son, Warrace Teel, Jr.; daughter-in-law, Marge Teel; sister, Joyce Arnold; step-daughter, Rochelle Roberts; nine grandchildren, several great grandchildren, nieces, nephews and many other relatives and friends.
