Warren Eric Fisher was born to the late John and Jessie Fisher on July 3, 1944 in Baltimore, Maryland. He transitioned to his heavenly home on December 21, 2019.

He attended Baltimore City Public Schools and received his G.E.D. in 1962. After receiving his G.E.D., Warren enlisted in the United States Armed Forces in November of 1962. He went on to complete 4 years of active military service. Upon his completion, Warren was transferred to the USAR Control Group where he served for 6 years.

Following his honorable discharge from the Armed Forces, Warren worked for Baltimore Transit and Bethlehem Steel. After leaving the steel yard, Warren began his career working with intellectual individuals at Star Flight, Inc. and continued his career with the prestigious CBAI, Inc. where he later retired in the spring of 2001.
