Warren Edward McArthur Jr., son of Jean Lena and Warren Edward McArthur Sr., was born August 14, 1969 in Baltimore, MD. He departed this life on Monday, July 4th 2016, after a lengthy illness.

"Chip" as he was known during his younger days received his education through the Baltimore City and Baltimore County School systems, graduating from Woodlawn High School in May 1986. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in March 1988. There he was tagged with the nickname "Mac" and served 12 years in the Military Police, attaining the rank of First Sergeant. He separated from the Army in June 2000.

During his time in the service, he met and married Fatima Mravunac (Mra-voo-nuts) on August 8, 1991. From this union two beautiful daughters were born, Sheila now 23 and Kyra now 19 years of age. Warren became not only a leader to his comrades, but also a friend to many of whom have stayed in contact with him through calls and Facebook.

Upon entering civilian life he worked for Wackenhut Security with his worksite designation, The Department of Justice (DOJ), Washington DC. Soon after he was offered and accepted a position working for the DOJ

as a Special Deputy U.S. Marshal. He held this position until his departure in November 2014.

Warren was a true "family man" as he enjoyed any time spent with family or friends. His hobbies included watching sports, especially football and baseball, whether it be televised or going to games. But cooking was his favorite hobby of all. He loved to watch TV shows where chefs prepared dishes that appealed to his palate. Then he'd prepare the meal and post it on his Facebook page for anyone to admire and comment.

He leaves behind to mourn his daughters, Sheila and Kyra; mother, Jean; father, Warren; Mother of his Children and Ex-Wife Fatima; grandmother, Lorraine; step-mother, Yeselle; half-sister, Tia; uncles, Stanley McArthur and Eugene Brown; aunts, Regina and Norma Brown, Martina and Arnita McArthur; numerous cousins, nieces, nephews and a host of others relatives and friends.

Warren was a devoted son and grandson, a loving father, and a great friend to those who knew him well. His light has gone out and he will truly be missed. But never ever forgotten.
