



## Wendell Leon Lewis

Although Wendell was born with mental challenges, he was a loyal, trustworthy and dependable friend. He looked out for everyone and it was those qualities that made him special. He will be missed by all who knew him.

Lewis, sisters, Brenda Taylor (Robert) and Vanessa Lyons (Roosevelt), brothers, Sandra Lee Lewis (Patricia) Warren and Gerome Lewis, aunt, Lenora W.
