Wesley Mansfield Gibson was born September 7, 1951 in Baltimore, Maryland. He was one of six children born to Lola Charity Gibson and Curtis Charles Gibson, Sr. At an early age, he was baptized at the Fulton Baptist Church, Baltimore, Maryland. He was a member of the Youth choir, Sunday school, Junior Missionaries, and as an adult, the Men's Chorus. He attended public schools in Baltimore, graduating from City College High School in 1970. Upon graduating from high school, Wesley entered the U.S. Army in 1971 and was honorably discharged in 1973. On September 10, 1972, he married Augustine Downs. To that union, one son was born, Wesley Jr. Wesley was a hard working, dedicated employee at the Union Memorial Hospital in Baltimore for more than 20 years. At the time of his death, the Rouse Company in Baltimore, Maryland employed him, where he had worked for the past eight years. Wesley was unassuming, organized, a good listener and an avid Baltimore Orioles and Ravens fan. He had a great sense of humor, was very generous and humble. His nieces and nephews affectionately referred to him as a "cuddly teddy bear." Wesley's favorite saying was "and everything." To know him, was to love him. He departed this life on October 24, 2002. He leaves to cherish his memory, one son, Wesley Jr.; a daughter-in-law, Rhonda Gibson; three grandsons, Justin and Jason Reynolds, and Jordan Lomax; one granddaughter, Diarra Gibson, all of Baltimore, M.D.; four brothers, Curtis C.
