WESLEY EDWARD THOMAS, affectionately known as “Sherriff,” was the son of the late Theodore and Viola Thomas. He was born on June 22, 1932 in Trelawny, Jamaica. The sun set on his life on Thursday, December 12, 2013 after a short illness.

He received his education in Trelawny, Jamaica. At the age of 29 he became employed by the Jamaican Postal Service. He traveled from Trelawny to Manchester where he met and married Gladys. Together they relocated to Kingston, Jamaica. He worked for the Post Office until he traveled to the United States in May 1968 with his oldest daughter, Shirlene (Susan) who was then 20 months, and two years later came his youngest daughter, Bernadette (Bernie). He started working as a longshoreman in 1975 and became a United States citizen in 1978.

From a previous relationship Sherriff had two children, a son Lawrence and a daughter Pauline Thomas who predeceased him.

Sherriff was very active in the Jamaican community. He had numerous friends and made friends wherever he went. He was a true friend and was a devoted family man who took great care of his queen and two princesses.
