October 7, 1945 - July 29, 2020

Weston “Wes” Calhoun was born on October 7, 1945 to the late Millicent and Ruth Ann David Calhoun in the Jordan Community in Manning, South Carolina. He was also preceded in death by one sister, Francena Calhoun Hilton.

He graduated from Manning Training School in 1963. He attended Mt. Chapel Baptist Church in his youth. After graduation he joined the United States Airforce where he served for four years, with one of those years deployed overseas in Japan. He was honorably discharged from the military in January, 1968.

In 1976, Weston pursued his higher education in liberal art studies at Passaic County Community College. During that time, Wes also joined the United States Army Reserves in Paterson, New Jersey where he served for 20 years and was honorably discharged September, 1996.

He was employed by Nabisco where he remained until he retired. Wes then moved to Virginia to live with his sister and extended family.

In the early morning of Wednesday, July 29, 2020 Weston departed this life at

Johnston Willis Hospital, Richmond Virginia.
