



## Wilber Marrow Lightfoot Sr.

Wilber Marrow Lightfoot, Sr. was born on September 17, 1939, in Sandston, Virginia, to the late Daniel and Viola Lightfoot. He peacefully entered eternal rest on May 27, 2026.
