He departed this life on Monday, December 25, 2006 after a lengthy illness. Brother Wilbert Person, better known as "Percy" to his loved ones, received his education through the public schools of Baltimore, Maryland and attended the University of the District of Columbia for music for four years. Wilbert had a passion for playing the saxophone, and he played for many churches. He joined the U.S Marine Corps in 1966, serving two enlistments and a four year tour in Vietnam, Southeast Asia. During his career he returned to Baltimore in 1969 and married Jamellia Davis. Wilbert also worked for ADT Security Systems as a telemarketer; he demonstrated exceptional skills (gift of gab) promoted to a created management position, shortly after starting with the company, and he worked there for five years. Wilbert gave his life to the Lord and received the Holy Ghost in 1978 and recognized where God had delivered him from, and decided to witness and minister to the lost and homeless and preached at several churches and missions. He was ordained November 1989 and was the founder and pastor of Blood on the Door Assembly of Jesus Church where he pastored for eleven years until his death.
