



## Wilbert G. Trusty Jr.

March 14, 1949 - June 4, 2019

Wilbert Gordon Trusty, Jr., affectionately known as Hank, the son of the late Wilbert Trusty, Sr. and Grace Trusty, departed this life on June 4, 2019. He was born in Baltimore, MD on March 14, 1949.

Wilbert was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System where he graduated from Forest Park High School in 1967. He worked for a short time for the Housing Authority of Baltimore before he was drafted into the Armed Services. After completing his tour of service, he returned to the Housing Authority where he moved from the ranks of a laborer to a supervisor. During that time, he rejoined the Armed Services in 1977 where he served a combination in active duty and the reserves for 23 years, retiring with the rank of Sargent First Class. He retired from the Housing Authority of Baltimore with over 40 years of service.
