You would often find him sitting at home on Sundays with his Mom, Dad, Naquawn and Josh. Those fortunate enough to know Billy knew how much he loved a good conversation and tasty food. During football season, his pastime would be rooting for his favorite team, the New England Patriots. Pool was his greatest hobby as he purchased Naquawn his first pool stick at the age of five. Always having time

to listen to others, he often offered his help in whatever way he could. He prided himself on mentoring young boys to complete their education and to follow the right path. Making numerous friends wherever he went, he will sincerely be missed by everyone who knew him.
