WILLIAM E. HARDY, son of the late Lether Hardy, was born May 28, 1933 in Grimesland, North Carolina. He departed this life on Wednesday, March 31, 2021.

William attended Pitt County Training School, now named G.R. Whitfield High School. He then joined the United States Army in May of 1953 and served through 1955. On August 15, 1955 he married the love of his life Gwendolyn L. Moore, and they later moved to Baltimore, Maryland. From their union came four sons. William was trained and duly examined by the Board of Examining Engineers in the City of Baltimore. He became Stationary Engineer first grade and worked for the State of Maryland for 32 years.
