EDWARD LEWIS HARRIS, son of the late Frank and Winnie Harris, was born on August 7, 1918 in Hanover Co., Ashland, Virginia. He departed this life at the age of ninety-two on August 29, 2010.

Eddie, as he was more affectionately known, received his education at St. Mark School during his youth. He worked and farmed alongside his father while in Virginia. He was a member of Ebenezer Baptist Church.

At the age twenty-one, Eddie left home to join the Army. He served during World War II from 1942-1946. After being honorably discharged, he came to Baltimore, Maryland. In 1946 he worked and retired after twenty-five years of service at Regal Laundry on Gilmore Street. While there, he met and married the late Maria A. Harris. They were married for thirty-five years.

In his younger days, Eddie enjoyed playing his guitar, going to parties and listening to music. He had a kind, gentle spirit, a wonderful personality and great sense of humor. Before he became ill, most of us knew where to find "Mr. Eddie" or "Pops"; beginning his day by walking through his community of Park Heights Avenue and Coldspring Lane, or taking his daily bus ride to sit center court at Mondawmin Mall. He would regularly end his day back at his "office" in the McDonald's on the corner of Coldspring Lane and Reisterstown Road.

Eddie was the last surviving sibling of three brothers and two sisters. He leaves to mourn: two sons, Craig Harris and Keith Harris (wife Sylvia); two daughters, Sonja Denise Jones and Lisa Watts (husband Noland); step-son, Ruloph McCrea (wife Gerry); seven grandchildren, Christopher, Kimberleigh, Niani, Kiara, Kai, Kailyn and Kamron. He also leaves to mourn: nephew, Melvin Mines; great-niece, Jonette Mines; and many other relatives. Eddie was known by many and will greatly missed by all his family and friends.
