September 26, 1906 - April 5, 2003

William Hibbert was born on September 26, 1906 in Content Gap, St. Andrew, Jamaica. He was the eldest of two children born to Jane Williams and Arnold Hibbert. On March 27, 1961 William was joined in Holy Matrimony to Ethel Mitchell, who predeceased him in August 1999. William worked at the Hearty's Tannery for many years before joining the Mosquito Eradication Control Team of the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation—a position he held until his retirement in 1975. After many years of studying the scriptures, William was baptized at an evangelistic crusade sponsored by the East Jamaica Conference of Seventh-day Adventist. He was a member of the Oak Glade Seventh-Adventist Church until he migrated to the United States in August 1999. William was a member of the Reisterstown Senior Center and prior to his illness; he was a member of the Senior Connection at Crondall Road. After four weeks of illness, William died on Saturday, April 5, 2003 at 2:30 p.m. while a patient at Good Samaritan Hospital. He awaits the life giver and leaves to mourn his passing daughters: Carmen, Faith and Dawn; son, David; grandchildren, Anita, Homer, Nickiesha and Kehoe; brother, Tata; nephews, in-laws and friends. William's daily words were, "food is not all, your mind has to be at peace." Those who love him will always remember him.
