William Sidney Scott, who was affectionately known as “Scottie” and “Bill”, was born on November 17, 1936 to the union of the late James and Hattie Scott in Durham, North Carolina. William was the sixth child out of eight children to James and Hattie. William was preceded in death by his sisters, Vivian Bennett, Gloria Timberlake and Ethel Johns. William was called home by our Lord and Savior after a sudden health crisis.

While growing-up in Durham, William and his siblings regularly attended the Mt. Gilliard Baptist Church. William received his education from the Durham Public School System and graduated from Hillside High School in 1955 where he studied auto mechanics.

William relocated to Baltimore, Maryland in the early 1960’s looking for job opportunities. Shortly after arriving to Baltimore, William gained employment at the Bethlehem Steel Corporation, as a laborer. While working at Bethlehem Steel in the late 1970s, William met Jean Green and the two married on March 22, 1983. From this union were born one child, James R. Scott. During his employment at Bethlehem Steel, William received several promotions and retired from the company as a supervisor.

After William retired, he spent his time “piddln” in his work shed and working on cars, particularly; his Fleetwood Cadillac.

After having a few joint replacement surgeries, William wasn't able to work on cars, but continued to do the things he loved, such as talking to friends and family on the phone, keeping with collegiate and professional sports, and going out every day to play the Maryland Lottery. William especially loved spending time with his family and friends.

William Sidney Scott departed this life on Saturday, November 4, 2017. 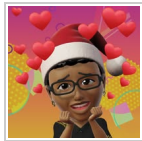
